## Corrigendum

As per the notification of the Pharmacy Council of India, Section 3.2.2 of the Information Bulletin for WBJEE-2018 published on 20/11/2017 is being revised as under.

<b>3.2.2</b>	<p><b>For admission to Pharmacy courses</b></p> <p>a) Candidate must have passed '10+2' examination with <b>Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics / Biology</b> as compulsory subjects with individual pass marks (in both theory and practical wherever applicable) in all the three subjects as stated above in <b>regular class</b> mode.</p> <p>b) Must have obtained at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category e.g. SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B, PwD) in the above three subjects taken together.</p> <p>c) Must have passed English in the '10+2' examination with at least 30% marks.</p> <p>d) The Board of the said Qualifying Examination must be recognized by the Central Government or State Government concerned. However the students possessing 10+2 qualification from non-formal and non-class rooms based schooling such as National Institute of Open Schooling, open school systems of States etc. shall not be eligible for admission to B. Pharm. Course.</p> <p>e) <b>The criteria for admission into Bachelor of Pharmacy course in Jadavpur University is given in section 3.3.1.2-a</b></p>
