**Instructions / Guidelines for JECA-2017 merit listed candidates seeking admission to Master in Computer Application (MCA) course in Universities / Institutes in West Bengal for the academic session 2017-18**

## **Eligibility Criteria**

### **(A) Minimum qualification for JECA-2017 qualified candidates for the academic session 2017-18**

All Universities, Govt. College and Self-financed Private Colleges that offer the three years Master of Computer Application (MCA) course in the State of West Bengal shall follow one of the four modules regarding eligibility criteria for admission of JECA-2017 qualified candidates in the said course for the 2016-17 academic session.

The four modules are:

**Module 1:** Candidate must have passed 3-years Bachelor degree program from UGC recognized University with at least 60% in Honours/Aggregate (45% for SC/ST candidates) or AICTE recognized BCA from any University/Institute along with 60% (45% for SC/ST candidates) marks in Mathematics at the Bachelor's level.

Candidates have to also secure at least 60% (45% for SC/ST candidates) marks in Secondary and Higher Secondary or equivalent level from recognized Boards with at least 60% (45% for SC/ST candidates) marks in Mathematics at each level.

**Module 2:** UGC and/or AICTE recognized (as the case may be) Bachelor's degree of minimum 3-years duration except BBA with Mathematics at 10+2 level or graduate level. Obtained 50% marks (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates) at graduation level.

**Module 3:** Graduate or equivalent degree under (10+2+3) pattern in any discipline of a UGC recognized University/Institute or AICTE recognized B.E./B.Tech/BCA of a University/Institute. Candidate must have Mathematics as one of the subjects at each level of education. Candidates have to secure 60% marks (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates) at each level.

**Module 4:** B.Sc. Honours degree under (10+2+3) pattern in any discipline of a UGC recognized University/Institute with at least 60% marks in Hons./Aggregate (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates) along with at least 55% marks in Mathematics. Candidate have to secure at least 60% marks in Secondary and Higher Secondary or equivalent level from recognized Boards with at least 60% marks in Mathematics at each level.

**Other Important Instructions / Guidelines for JECA-2017 counselling :**

- a) Candidates have to register online through the link at website: [www.wbjeeb.in](http://www.wbjeeb.in) provide necessary information, and pay **Rs. 500/-** as registration fee by debit card/credit card/net banking and download the registration form.
- b) Candidates must report at the counselling venue on the specific date **before** his/her reporting time slot stipulated for her/him.
- c) Candidates need to carry with them the documents and their self attested copies as listed above.
- d) Candidates will be called for counselling in sequence of their GMR.
- e) On successful verification of documents, the candidate will be allotted a seat according to his/her order of choice/ preference and availability of the seat at that instant.
- f) Candidates should note that allotment of a seat in any University/ Institute by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board is entirely provisional and is subject to fulfillment of the eligibility and other criteria specific to the allotted University / Institute for admission to Master in Computer Application course. If the candidate does not possess the said eligibility criteria his allotment would be cancelled outright at the moment of detection at any level( upto Registration in the concerned University).

Such eligibility and other criteria would be verified by the concerned University / Institute where the candidate has been allotted by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board at the time of admission.

- g) Candidates belonging to states other than West Bengal shall not be considered for admission to Govt. Engineering colleges.
- h) Reservation of seats for SC / ST / PWD / OBC-A / OBC-B is applicable to the candidates of the State of West Bengal only. SC / ST / PWD / OBC-A / OBC-B candidates of other States can not avail of this facility.
- i) **For Government and Govt. aided Engineering & Technological Colleges the reservation of seats for SC / ST / PWD / OBC-A / OBC-B candidates will be as per Government Rules. For Universities / University Departments reservation rules in case of SC / ST / PWD / OBC-A / OBC-B candidates of the concerned Universities shall be followed.**
- j) Appearance of a rank in the counselling schedule does not guarantee a seat in any University / Institute . Counselling for allotment of seats will be stopped as soon as the last vacant seat is filled up and no further queries in this regard will be entertained.

- k) The claim of a candidate to exercise option shall be limited to the vacancies prevalent at that instant when his / her turn comes for appearing before the counselling officials.
- l) The option will have to be exercised at the time of counselling. Once the allotment of a seat in any University / Institute is done no further change of the University / Institute will be entertained.
- m) A candidate failing to appear before the counselling officials at the allotment counter on the schedule date and time in order of his / her position in the list owing to delay on his / her part may be allowed to appear before the counselling officials after verifying the testimonials regarding eligibility criteria and would be considered for allotment of seat in any University / Institute available at that instant only irrespective of his / her rank.
- n) No refund of counselling fee is admissible.
- o) Modification of the counselling schedule may be brought about under exigent circumstances.
- p) Candidates will be required to take admission to the allotted University / Institute within five days from the date of allotment.
- q) Any candidate appearing at the counselling with fake documents/testimonials will be handed over to the police instantly.

## **Reservation Policy**

### **Availability of seats for SC/ST Category**

Reservation of seats for SC/ST candidates domiciled in West Bengal shall be made as per the State Govt. Rules, in respect of all Govt. Engineering & Technology Colleges as well as State-aided universities/University Departments following the Gazette Notification vide the West Bengal Act X of 2013, dated, 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2013 followed by the Rules vide Notification no. 07-Edu(U), dated, the 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 2014 published in the Kolkata Gazette vide Registered no. WB/SC-247, dated 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2014. For Self-Financing Engineering & Technology/Pharmacy Institutions, reservation of seats for such students is not mandatory. However, seats may be made available by willing Institutions, and this would be reflected in the Seat Matrix provided in the website for counseling.

### **Availability of seats for PwD (Persons with Disabilities) Category Students**

Reservation of seats for PwD candidates domiciled in West Bengal shall be made as per the State Govt. norms for all Govt. Engineering & Technology Colleges as well as State-aided universities/University Departments following the Gazette Notification vide no. 65-Edn(U), dated 16.01.2014 i.e. persons with Disabilities will enjoy a 3% reservation in each of the categories i.e. SC, ST, OBC-A and OBC-B category of seats as well as in the Unreserved Category of seats. For Self Financing Engineering & Technology/Pharmacy Institutes, reservation of seats for such students is not mandatory. However, seats may be made available by willing Institutions, and this would be reflected in the Seat Matrix of JECA-2017 provided in the website for counseling.

### **For admission to MCA course under PwD category**

For PwD (loco motor disorder, visual impairment, speech and hearing impairment) category candidate a minimum of 40% disability is required subject to the condition that the candidate is capable of carrying out all activities related to theory and practical work as applicable to MCA course without any special concession and exemption.

### **Availability of seats for OBC-A and OBC-B Category students**

As per the Gazette Notification, vide the West Bengal Act X of 2013, dated, 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2013 followed by the Rules vide Notification no. 07-Edn(U), dated, 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 2014 published in the Kolkata Gazette vide Registered no. WB/SC-247, dated, 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2014, reservation of seats for such categories of students is applicable for Govt. Engineering & Technology Colleges and State-Aided universities/University Departments subject to certain preconditions such as prior approval of regulatory authorities, creation/availability of infrastructure etc. In the academic session of 2017-18, availability of seats for OBC-A category and OBC-B category would be reflected in the Seat Matrix provided in the website for counseling. For Self-Financing Engineering & Technology/Pharmacy Institutes, reservation of seats for such students is not mandatory. However, seats may be made available by willing Institutions, which would be reflected in the Seat Matrix for JECA-2017 provided in the website for counseling.

**Procedure to be followed in case of candidates unable to appear in the counselling in person owing to valid reason**

If any candidate is unable to appear in the counselling in person owing to valid reasons under exceptional circumstances / medical ground, his/her parent/guardian may be permitted to appear in the counselling on her/his behalf with the following documents.

- i) Authorization letter from the candidate attesting the signature of his/her parent/guardian and also declaring in the said authorization letter that he/she would not claim any seat in the Institution other than the one allotted to him/her through his/her representative by authorization.
- ii) Medical Certificate from a registered practitioner and Doctor's prescription.
- iii) All original testimonials as mentioned under heading "Documents to carry" are to be brought positively by the candidates during counselling"
